First reading: Exodus: 12:1-8. 11-14 We hear the instructions given to the Chosen people when they were held captive in Egypt. The instructions give them the detail of preparation and eating what became the Passover meal so that through history, each generation of participants could share in the blessing as if they too had come out of Egypt.
